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Amber necklace




This is the necklace for the level 2. This means that you might need to do some adjustments to the pattern and you need to understand how the pattern works before you can do this.

The stone chips are of different size. Check your chips. How many seed beads can be measured along the hole of your stone or crystal bead? In my diagram I have big amber chips and it is 3 seed beads equal to the length of their holes. All diamond shapes made with the seed beads look nice and levelled because of this adjustment.

Look at the top row of the amber beads. It is a bead, a stone and a bead before a diamond shape. The next diamond does not have an amber bead on its top. Though it has 5 seed beads: a bead, 3 beads (equal to the amber) and one bead again.

The same reason is why I have 3 beads between the hanging amber beads. This is why they hang in a nice triangle shape.





One of our group members – Tammy – wrote this instructions for her blind friend who likes beading. Tammy kindly allowed me to publish her instruction, so that was what I did. It will be our pleasure if anybody finds it useful too.

PEARL NECKLACE

Makes triangular shapes

- 1. Add 20 beads-7 Bronze-9 Gold-4 Bronze
- 2. Skip bottom bead and go back up through 4 beads
- 3. add 7 beads-7 Gold
- 4. go up through 5 beads Go to fringe from where you come out of 4 count up 8 beads go into eighth bead and come out twelfth bead
- 5. Add 4 beads4 Bronze
- 6. Add Pearl
- 7. Add 4 beads4 Gold
- 8. Go down through 1 bead—The 4th bead down from where you went up through the 5 beads
- 9. Add 4 beads-4 Gold
- 10. Add Pearl
- 11. Add 1 Bead-1 Bronze
- 12. Skip bead and go back up through Pearl
- 13. Go up through bead directly above Pearl
- 14. Add 7 beads-7 Gold
- 15. Go up through bead under Pearl and Through Pearl
- 16. Add 11 beads- 7 Bronze-4 Gold
- 17. Go down through 1 bead—The 5th bead down from the bottom of the Pearl
- 18. Add 8 beads-4 Gold-4 Bronze
- 19. Skip bottom bead and go back up through 4 beads
- 20. Add 7 beads-7Gold
- 21. go up through 5 beads Go to fringe from where you come out of 4 count up 8 beads go into eighth bead and come out twelfth bead
- 22. Repeat from # 5 until you have the length you want and put clasps on the ends.

You can also just do this in the front and do loops for the sides and back, String beads for your necklace after you do as much of the design as you want then come back and make loops, string on 5-10 beads however long you want the loops then count out the number of beads you want to skip and go in a bead then just keep repeating. The more beads on your string and the less beads you skip the longer the loop the less beads on the string and the more beads you skip the shorter the loop. That would be pretty.
