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


I would like to draw your attention to the fact, that 1 bangle in my necklace is equal to the length of 4 of my seed beads. If your bangle is shorter than the length of your 4 beads for your necklace, then you need to make an adjustment. Look, there are 4 seed beads on the top row between each diamond shape. This is exactly why.

If your bangles' length is equal to the 3 seed beads that you are going to use, then you need to use only 3 beads between each diamond shape.



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
