## A tip for those who cannot knit, though would like tamake their cloths unique with a help of the seed beads



Well, let's do it!
As soon as a beading needle appeared in your house, make use of it as often as you can, for example, fo $r$ sewing buttons. $F$ irst sew a button and after it has been already done, add beads on top (beads should be no bigger than size 8 or 9 ). Four or six beads will do for one button; their color and location depend on your imagination.

I can suggest one simple way of making chic attire out of a plain single colored blouse. First sew all the buttons with the beads on top (I like to use pearl buttons of the mother s of pearl). Then sew the beads along the edge of the collar - choose the beads of one color and then you may fill the angles of the collar with the beads of another color. Then you may repeat the embroidery on the cuffs .

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
